## MASSBAY HIRES ASSISTANT PROVOST FOR STUDENT AFFAIRS AND ENROLLMENT MANAGEMENT

Wellesley Hills, Mass. – Marva Perry will assume the position of Assistant Provost for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management at Massachusetts Bay Community College (MassBay), as announced by President Carole Berotte Joseph and Provost John Donnelly. Perry has served in this role on an interim basis since 2006 and will permanently take over. She was hired after an extensive national search.

Prior to joining MassBay in 2006, Perry was the Vice President for Student Development at Wheelock College in Boston, Massachusetts for 12 years. She has extensive experience in development and supervision of multiple areas, including Academic Advising, Admissions, Athletics, Recreation, and Wellness, Career Services, Counseling Services, Financial Aid, Health Education Services, Registration and Records, Student Activities, and Student Development.

"Given the solid contributions that she has already made to MassBay, her varied background and the broad set of experiences she possesses, she is uniquely suited to assist in the success of all MassBay learners."

Perry has been involved in higher education since 1971, working at five different institutions over the course of her career. She has served in the roles of Assistant Provost, Assistant Dean, Supervisor, Counselor, Chairperson, and Faculty member.

"I am pleased to have Marva join the leadership team," said Provost Donnelly. "I am appreciative of her leadership of the student affairs area during her past two years serving as Interim Assistant Provost. I am excited that Marva will be a permanent addition to my team and I look forward to working with her to fulfill the strategic mission of achieving excellence at MassBay."

Perry received her bachelor's degree from Eastern Kentucky University. She went on to receive a master's degree in counseling psychology from Boston College and is ABD from Harvard University. She has served as a consultant for various constituencies.

"I am delighted to accept the position as the Assistant Provost for Student Affairs and Enrollment Management," said Perry. As MassBay continues to make its mark in higher education, I look forward to continuing to work collaboratively with members of the MassBay family to enhance our role in the larger community.
