General Business: Hospitality Management Certificate

The Hospitality Management Certificate program is designed to provide the skills students need to enter the field of hotel management, or to enhance the skills of those already in the hospitality industry. Courses focus on the specific knowledge needed in the industry, and the Service Industry Internship provides students with relevant and useful workplace experience.

The coursework completed as part of the certificate program fulfills many of the course requirements of the Hospitality Management Associate in Science. Many students continue in a full-or part-time basis to complete their associate degree.

The certificate program can be taken with another program including appropriate liberal studies, leading to an Associate Degree in General Business.

Upon successful completion, the Certificate in General Business with a concentration in Hospitality Management is awarded.
