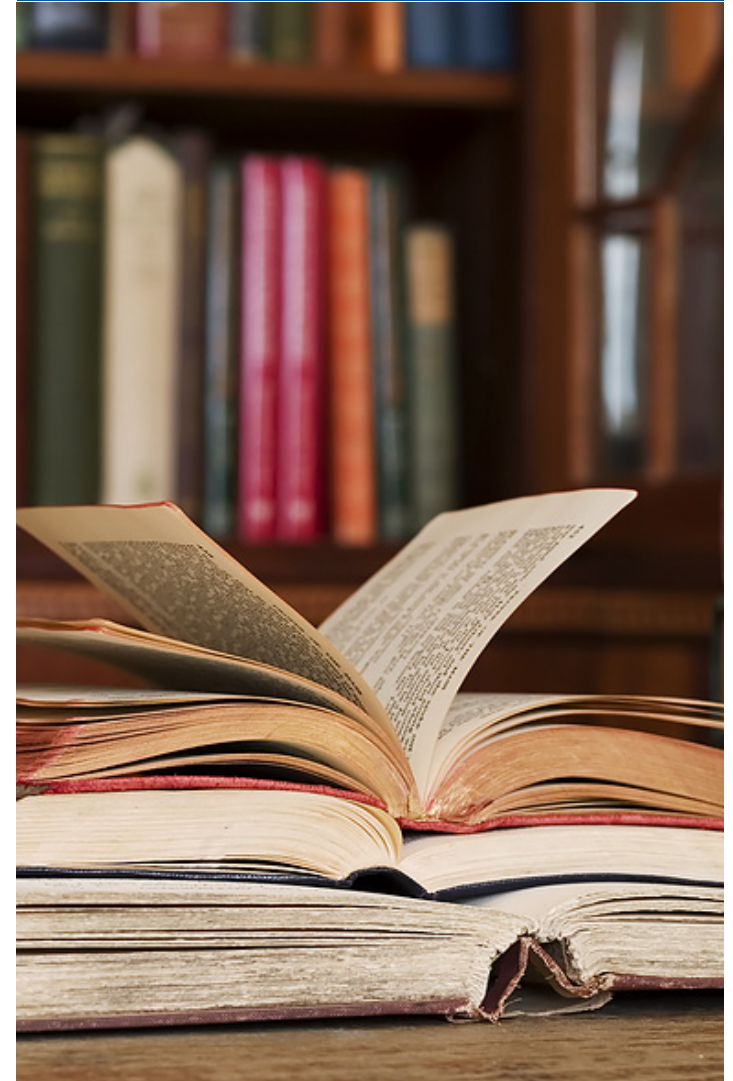

## What is Intersession?

Intersession is the period between the fall semester and the spring semester. At MassBay that period is Tuesday, January 3, 2012 through Wednesday, January 18, 2012. Courses run during this time period are accelerated. A student completes 3 or 4 credit academic course in a two week period. Instead of a course meeting for three hours over fifteen weeks, the course meets four and a half hours over eleven days. The number of classroom hours is the same as if the class was run over a regular fifteen week semester.

## Who should enroll in Intersession?

**Current MassBay students** who wish to get a jump start on the spring semester or lighten their load for the spring semester. **Students from other colleges and universities** that wish to take a course to transfer.
