President's Scholars Scholarship

This scholarship is available for academically superior high school students who are entering MassBay Community College. The purpose of this scholarship is to attract and retain local academic scholars to MassBay Community College regardless of financial need.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Graduation from a high school, accredited by the Massachusetts Department of Education with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0 and/or be in the top 10% of their high school's graduating class.
- 2) Commonwealth of Massachusetts residency required.
- 3) Applicant must take the MassBay College Placement Test and place into Freshman English I (EN101) and a 100-level college Mathematics. Placement test must be completed by March 28th. Contact the Director of Admissions at 781-239-2501 to arrange your test.
- 4) Enroll at MassBay Community College in the subsequent fall semester immediately following high school graduation as a full-time (12 or more credits) student in a program leading to an Associate's Degree.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1) Recipients will be nominated by the President's Scholars Scholarship Committee.
- 2) Nominations will be reviewed by the President of the College.
- 3) Submitted to the MassBay Foundation Board of Directors for approval.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1) Apply online. Visit us at www.massbay.edu/apply
- 2) Complete and submit the scholarship application cover sheet.
- 3) Submit two letters of recommendation from the high school signed by either teachers or officials at the school.
- 4) Submit an official high school transcript.
- 5) Submit a 500 – 700 word essay on a topic that has impacted his/her life.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1) Deadline for yearly applications is April 1st.
- 2) Applications are reviewed by the Scholarship Committee by April 8th.
- 3) Recommendations are sent to the Executive Director of the MassBay Foundation by April 9th.
- 4) Final selection of recipients by MassBay Foundation Board of Directors by April 11th.

AWARD

The scholarship includes full tuition and fees for two consecutive academic years at MassBay. In order to maintain the President's Scholars Scholarship the recipients must be enrolled full time (12 or more credits) in college level classes and maintain a 3.0 cumulative grade point average. Scholarship recipients will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee at the end of each semester to ensure continued compliance with guidelines. Number of recipients awarded each year is determined by the Foundation Board of Directors and is contingent on fund balances.
