MassBay Community College – Liberal Arts AA Bay Path College – Bachelor of Arts Liberal Studies and other programs

Summary of Agreement:

- This general agreement will provide graduates from the Liberal Arts A.A. program at MassBay Community College into the Liberal Studies B.A. program (or other approved programs) at Bay Path College
- Students also may participate in Joint Admissions with Bay Path College while attending MassBay. This will allow for further advisement on course selection from Bay Path College Undergraduate Admissions into select programs

Admissions and Enrollment Guidelines:

- All MassBay Community College graduates must complete the Bay Path College admissions process, including filling out the Intent to Enroll form, a regular application for admission, providing official transcripts from all institutions attended, and any other documents that may be required.
- All MassBay Community College graduates must have a cumulative GPA of **2.0** (on a 4.0 scale) in order to be guaranteed admission.
- Bay Path College will accept a maximum of 60 credits. Students are encouraged to select a similar course of study to maximize transfer of credit to Bay Path. A flow chart has been provided below.
 - Students considering Forensic Science, Education, and Occupational Therapy must meet cumulative gpa requirements and program requirements for these programs.

Financial Aid and Scholarships:

- All applicants are encouraged to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine scholarship, grant, and loan eligibility. To find out more information regarding financial aid possibilities for transfer students, please contact the financial aid office of the institution in this agreement.
- Merit-Based financial aid is available from Bay Path College and ranges from \$5000 to \$9000 a year. The range is determined by grade point average.
