MassBay Community College – Approved Associate Degree Programs Bay State College – Approved Bachelor’s Degree Programs

Summary of Agreement:

This general agreement will provide graduates from an approved Associate degree program at MassBay Community College, guaranteed admission into an approved Bachelor degree program at Bay State College

Admission and Enrollment Guidelines:

- MassBay Community College graduates will complete the Undergraduate Transfer Application at Bay State College. All requirements must be completed except for the application fee. This will be waived by Bay State College
- All MassBay Community College graduates must have a cumulative GPA of **2.3** (on a 4.0 scale) in order to be offered guaranteed admission.
- Bay State College will accept a minimum of 60 credits being the student received a “**C**” or higher in the course. Students are encouraged to select a similar course of study to maximize transfer of credit to Lasell College.
- Bay State College will honor the MasTransfer Block if noted on the student transcript.
- CLEP, AP, and Challenge Exams accepted by MassBay will be honored at Bay State College.

Financial Aid and Scholarships:

- All applicants are encouraged to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine scholarship, grant, and loan eligibility. To find out more information regarding financial aid possibilities for transfer students, please contact the financial aid office of the institution in this agreement.
- Bay State College participates in the Yellow Ribbon Program and the post 9/11 G.I Bill. Under these programs, Bay State can contribute additional funds to help assist veterans further their education.
