Summary of Agreement:

This agreement will provide graduates of the Business Administration program at MassBay Community College with guaranteed admission and transfer of over 60 credits into the Business Administration program at Bryant University. Please refer to the chart below detail on the transfer of credit.

Admissions and Enrollment Guidelines:

- MassBay graduate must complete the entire Bryant University Undergraduate Transfer Application. The application fee will be waived. Students must provide official transcripts from MassBay and any other institutions attended.
- All MassBay Community College students must have a cumulative GPA of **3.0 or higher** (on a 4.0 scale) in order to receive guaranteed admission.
- Bryant University will accept a maximum of 62 semester credit hours from the approved program. Only grades of C or higher will be accepted. This may lower the total number of credit accepted below 62 credits.
- AP and CLEP credit honored by MassBay must be shared with Bryant University. Students must send an official score sheet to Bryant University directly from The College Board.

Financial Aid and Scholarships:

All applicants are encouraged to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine scholarship, grant, and loan eligibility. To find out more information regarding financial aid possibilities for transfer students, please contact the financial aid office of the institution in this agreement.

Bryant University participates in the Yellow Ribbon Program and the Post 9/11 G.I. Bill. Under these programs, Bryant University can contribute additional funds to help assist veterans further their education. Veterans utilizing this agreement are encouraged to meet with admissions staff at Bryant University for more information.
