Summary of Agreement:

This agreement provides graduates of Automotive Technology Associate Degree programs from MassBay Community College with a guaranteed transfer option to the Pittsburg State's Bachelors of Applied Science in Technology degree (BAS).

Admissions and Enrollment Guidelines:

- This program offers students who have graduated from an accredited two-year associate degree technical program (MassBay) the opportunity to extend their education and training. All associate degree graduates (with a minimum GPA of 2.50) can automatically transfer up to 64 college credits to Pittsburg State.
- Recommended student takes PS101/SO101/HS203 as Social Science Elective, SF131 for a humanities elective at MassBay if possible.
- Graduates receive a Bachelor of Applied Science degree with a major in technology and a selected emphasis by completing an additional minimum of 60 hours from PSU. The degree program content is based on previous academic and technical preparation.
