#### **Summary of Agreement:**

This agreement provides graduates of Automotive Technology Associate Degree programs from MassBay Community College with a guaranteed transfer option to the Automotive Technology Management Bachelor Degree program at Pennsylvania College of Technology. Program can be complete on-site or via distance learning.

#### **Admissions and Enrollment Guidelines:**

- Students may transfer from completed associate degrees related to automotive, collision repair or automotive management regionally accredited colleges (MassBay) with equivalent courses
- Transcripts will be evaluated by Penn College officials prior to acceptance to the major and junior level status.
- All MassBay Community College graduates must have a cumulative GPA of **2.5** (on a 4.0 scale) in order to be guaranteed admission. Student with a lower GPA may still be eligible for this admission to program.
- Students will be guaranteed transfer of a minimum of 60 credits toward the Automotive Management degree. Students may receive additional credits (over 60 credits) depending on electives selected by MassBay student.
- Recommended student take EC201 or EC202 as Social Science Elective, PH102 for a humanities elective at MassBay

#### **Financial Aid and Scholarships:**

All applicants are encouraged to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine scholarship, grant, and loan eligibility.
