#### **Summary of Agreement:**

This agreement provides graduates of the select Associate Degree programs from MassBay Community College with a guaranteed transfer option to an academic program in the area of Arts and Sciences at Wheelock College.

#### **Admissions and Enrollment Guidelines:**

- All MassBay Community College graduates must apply to Wheelock within one year of completing their degree, and complete the entire Wheelock College admission process to be eligible.
- All MassBay Community College graduates must have a cumulative GPA of **2.0** (on a 4.0 scale) in order to be guaranteed admission.
- MassBay graduates will receive credit for courses completed with a grade of C or higher. Upon acceptance to Wheelock, the remaining 50% of the degree must be completed with appropriate courses with a grade of C or higher. Assistance from a faculty or professional advisor will be provided.
- A simple course equivalency has been provided below. All efforts will be made to accept college level credit taken outside of this equivalency by Wheelock College.

#### **Financial Aid and Scholarships:**

Students with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher shall be eligible for a Wheelock Scholarship up to \$12,500 per year. (Wheelock Boston Campus only) This scholarship is renewable contingent upon maintaining full-time status and a 3.0 grade point average at Wheelock.

All applicants are encouraged to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine scholarship, grant, and loan eligibility.
