MassBay Community College – Business Administration A.S. New England College of Business and Finance – Business Administration B.S.

Summary of Agreement:

This general agreement will provide graduates the Business Administration Associate in Science program from MassBay Community College guaranteed admission into the Business Administration Bachelor of Science program at New England College of Business and Finance.

Admission and Enrollment Guidelines:

- MassBay Community College graduates will complete the Undergraduate Transfer Application at New England College of Business and Finance. All requirements must be completed, except for the application fee. This will be waived by NECB.
- Business Administration graduates from MassBay must have a cumulative GPA of **2.0** (on a 4.0 scale) in order to be offered guaranteed admission.
- NECB will accept the credits outlined in the flow sheet below. Only grades of C or higher will be accepted. Students that have a C- or lower in any courses may have complete more credit to graduate from NECB.
- Students who have not fulfilled an NECB prerequisite at MassBay may be asked to complete the requirement at NECB.

Financial Aid and Scholarships:

- All applicants are encouraged to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine scholarship, grant, and loan eligibility. To find out more information regarding financial aid possibilities for transfer students, please contact the financial aid office of the institution in this agreement.
- New England College of Business and Finance participates in the Yellow Ribbon Program and the post 9/11 G.I Bill. Under these programs, NECB can contribute additional funds to help assist veterans further their education. Veterans utilizing this agreement are encouraged to meet with admissions staff at NECB for more information.
