



Articulation Agreement Summary Sheet

MassBay Community College – Associate in Arts or Associate in Science Newbury College – Bachelor in Arts or Bachelor in Science (Multiple Programs)

Summary of Agreement:

This is a general agreement that provides graduates of approved Associate degree programs from MassBay Community College with an opportunity to be admitted into select Bachelor degree programs at Newbury College with a minimum of 60 transferable credits. Credit maximum is 75.

Admissions and Enrollment Guidelines:

- All MassBay Community College graduates must complete the entire Newbury College Undergraduate Transfer Application; provide official transcripts from all prior institutions, and any other required documents.
- Newbury College will waive the application fee. Please include this form.
- All MassBay Community College students must have a cumulative GPA of **2.5** (on a 4.0 scale) and an associate degree in an approved program (**See chart below**) in order to be guaranteed admission.
- Only courses with a grade of C or higher will transfer to Newbury College
- Newbury College will accept all AP, CLEP, and Challenge Exam credit awarded at MassBay. Student must provide forms from The College Board to receive credit.

Financial Aid and Scholarships:

All applicants are encouraged to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine scholarship, grant, and loan eligibility. To find out more information regarding financial aid possibilities for transfer students, please contact the financial aid office of the institution in this agreement.

Newbury College participates in the Yellow Ribbon Program and the Post 9/11 G.I. Bill. Under these programs, Newbury College may contribute additional funds to help assist veterans further their education. Veterans utilizing this agreement are encouraged to meet with the Registrar at Newbury College for more information.
