MassTransfer

MASSTRANSFER BLOCK

The MassTransfer Block is a great transfer option for students planning to transfer before completing an Associate Degree. Students that complete this block of credit will have their General Education / Core Requirements at Massachusetts Public Institutions waived. The block consists of the following courses

English Composition/Writing (6 credits)
Behavioral & Social Sciences (9 credits)
Humanities & Fine Arts (9 credits)
Natural & Physical Sciences (7 credits)
Mathematics (3 credits)

MASSTRANSFER ASSOCIATE DEGREES

Associate degrees approved in MassTransfer, automatically include the MassTransfer Block, and the remaining credit in the program has been reviewed by four-year public institutions to ensure transferability. Students that graduate from these programs will receive the following benefits based on their final GPA at graduation.

Minimum Final GPA	Transfer Benefits
2.0 GPA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No admission fee or essay Transfer of 60 credits applied to the bachelor's degree Automatic satisfaction of the general education requirements.
2.5 GPA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All of the above benefits, plus guaranteed admission
3.0 GPA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All of the above benefits, plus a 33% tuition waiver

ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS

Students are often concerned about how their course will transfer from one institution to the next. Transfer Agreements (commonly referred to as Articulation Agreements) help alleviate these concerns. If a Transfer Agreement is in place, it means that faculty at an outside



institution have thoroughly evaluated an academic program from MassBay for approval. Benefits of a transfer agreement commonly include transfer of all college-level course work and/or guaranteed admission.

Student seeking to utilize a college agreement should print the appropriate summary sheet and include it with their application to the school. If the student applies online, the summary sheet should be mailed in with any other documentation including, personal essays, recommendations, or official transcripts.
