



## Articulation Agreement Summary Sheet

### MassBay Community College – Associate in Arts or Associate in Science Regis College – Bachelor in Arts or Bachelor in Science (Multiple Programs)

#### Summary of Agreement:

This is a general agreement that provides graduates of approved Associate degree programs from MassBay Community College with an opportunity to be admitted into select Bachelor degree programs at Regis College with a minimum of 60 transferable credits. Please refer to the chart below for articulated programs.

#### Admissions and Enrollment Guidelines:

- All MassBay Community College graduates must complete the entire Regis College Undergraduate Transfer Application, provide official transcripts from all prior institutions, and any other required documents.
- All MassBay Community College students must have a cumulative GPA of **2.5** (on a 4.0 scale) and an associate degree in an approved program (**See chart below**) in order to be guaranteed admission.
- Students who meet the requirements of this agreement Joint Admissions Agreement and who complete the general education core curriculum will be guaranteed a minimum of 60 semester hour credits (80 quarter hour credits) being the student received a **C** or higher in those courses.
- Students who complete the MasTransfer block at MassBay Community College will have their general education requirements waived. The receiving institution (Regis College) reserves the right to require accepted student to complete 2 specific courses to satisfy further requirements. No other MasTransfer benefits will be provided. This includes Challenge Exams, AP, and CLEP Credit.
- Students are encouraged to utilize the Regis College / MassBay Community course equivalency to maximize course applicability.

#### Financial Aid and Scholarships:

All applicants are encouraged to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine scholarship, grant, and loan eligibility.
