Knights fall to No. 4 Mass Bay CC

The CCRI Knights men's basketball team traveled to Wellesley Height, Mass. on Saturday to play the No. 4 Buccaneers of Massachusetts Bay Community College. The Knights lost to the Buccaneers 77-65.

The Mass Bay Buccaneers showed why they are the No.4 team, as they held the Knights to 31 percent shooting from the field. Mass Bay CC took a 31-23 lead into halftime. The Knights never cut the deficit to less than five points in the second half.

Though the Knights had four players score in double figures, it was not enough, as Mass Bay's one-two punch of Sam Etienne and Rob Hunter, who scored 16 points each, were too tough to handle.

Leading the way for the Knights was Trevor Mabry (Norwich, Conn.), who scored 11 points with five rebounds, and Addison Williams (Boulder, Colo.), who had 11 points. Also contributing for the Knights was captain Mike Juarez (Cranston, R.I.) with 11 points and Mike Rivera (Boston, Mass.), who added 10 points.

"Today we looked emotionally and physically drained, which is not a good recipe versus a team like Mass Bay CC," head coach Rick Harris said.
