**MASSBAY TO PARTICIPATE IN MCCAC TOURNAMENT**  
*Buccaneer men play over weekend*

**Wellesley Hills, Mass.** – The Massachusetts Bay Community College (MassBay) men's basketball team will play in this weekend's Massachusetts Community College Athletic Conference (MCCAC) Tournament to be held February 23-24, 2008 at Quinsigamond Community College.

The Buccaneers finished the regular season at 17-10 and are the fourth seed in the four-team tournament. They will face top-seeded Springfield Tech Saturday at 4:00 p.m. in the first game of the semifinal bracket. Second-seeded Massasoit will face off against third-seeded Quinsigamond at 6:00 p.m.

The winners will meet in the MCCAC Championship Sunday at 2:00 p.m. All games will be played at Quinsigamond Community College on 670 West Boylston Street in Worcester, Massachusetts. Admission is free.

The MCCAC was established in 1969 for the purpose of promoting and fostering Community College athletics in Massachusetts to the end that the results of intercollegiate athletics will be consistent with the total educational program. There are 15 community colleges in Massachusetts. As many as 14 and as few as eight colleges have participated in intercollegiate athletics since the conference was established.

The National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Tournament starts February 27, with Region 21 action.
