## REGISTRATION BEGINS NOVEMBER 4TH!

Registration for the spring 2020 term as well as winter intersession courses begins on Monday, November 4th.

Now is the time to meet with your academic advisor to review your academic plan and course selections for next semester. If you are a new student, you will need to have your COMPASS meeting with your advisor before you register. Your academic advisor is prepared to help you create a plan to reach your goals, as well as devise strategies to stay on the path to completing your plan.



## HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR ADVISING/COMPASS MEETING:

1. Contact your advisor to set up an appointment. You can find your advisor's name and contact information in BayNavigator (see below).
2. Utilize the online Course Master to review course options for spring.
3. Review your program requirements and your current academic progress. You can view your requirements and progress using the MyMAP tool in Bay Navigator.
4. Consider your goals and plans for after MassBay. You may find it helpful to speak with your professors and mentors in addition to your advisor.
5. Be aware of add, drop, and payment deadlines. If you applied for financial aid and are unsure of your aid award for spring, check-in with the Financial Aid office.
