Haven and AlcoholEdu

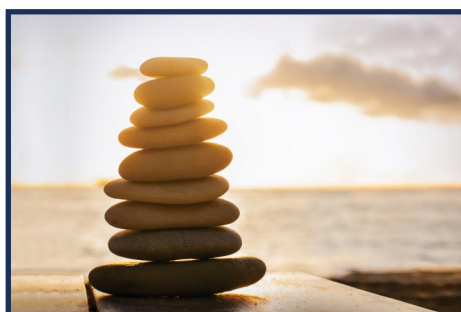
This week you will be receiving a message to your MassBay email about an important partnership with **EverFi**, whose mission is to help college students across the country address critical life skills such as alcohol abuse prevention and sexual assault prevention.

This program is part of our efforts to ensure that our community has access to information and support for wellness education.

We now offer two online **EverFi** programs, Haven and AlcoholEdu, to our campus community.

Each year over ½ million students complete these courses for the purpose of improving the lives of everybody on campus. By offering these courses, MassBay is joining the national effort to help eliminate sexual violence on college campuses, which is strengthened by the Campus Sexual Violence Elimination Act (SaVE), signed into law by President Obama in March 2013.

In addition to these programs, we will be hosting opportunities for students, faculty, and staff to have in person conversations about healthy relationships, consent, and overall health and wellness.
