36-Hour Course: Upon completion, students will receive a certificate stating "36 hours of instruction – the equivalent of 3 credits"

WK40 - 300 Equality in the USA

April 6 – May 1 Cost: \$350

This course will probe the guiding question: What does prejudice, racism and discrimination have to do with equality in the USA? We will examine the topics of Women's Rights, Religious Freedom, Rights for Immigrants, Native Americans and Latinos, as well as equality for Americans with Disabilities, LGBT and African Americans.

WK42 - 300 Hospitality: The Art & Science of Customer Service April 6 – May 1 Cost: \$350

Customer service is at the heart of this industry. There is an art and science needed to master it. This course will include a survey of the various segments of the hospitality industry. Industry standards, management styles, and communication strategies in a culturally diverse, global society will be examined.

WK43 - 300 Massachusetts: Hub of Innovation

April 20 - May 15 Cost: \$350

Massachusetts was named in the top two of most innovative states in America in 2019 (Bloomberg). This course will introduce students to some of the major advances, discoveries and inventions that originated in Massachusetts and will explain their influences in the past and present on human life. Students will examine the traits and of innovators and the work cultures that foster innovative thinking. Students will debate what's next for Massachusetts's hub of innovation.
