

COMPUTER LAB RULES

MassBay Community College's student computers are primarily for academic use.

*Reminder: by logging onto a MassBay computer or website, you agree to follow **ALL** of these rules.*

Below are some key rules that all students should be aware of.

You are responsible for all activities conducted on your MassBay user ID:

- **Do not** give your MassBay password to anyone - if you believe someone is using your MassBay password, change it or ask for assistance from the lab staff or HelpDesk
- **Do not** log on for anyone else (including relatives and friends) - use of these computer resources is paid through **your current** student fees
- **Don't forget to log out** before leaving the Computer Lab
- **Never** engage in any activity that might be harmful to the system/network, such as creating or propagating viruses, disrupting services, or deleting/damaging MassBay or system files

Be considerate of others in the computer lab:

- When speaking with others in the labs or on the phone, please **keep your voice quiet**
- When listening to audio, **always** use headphones or earbuds
- Cell phones must be on "Silent Mode." No outgoing calls are permitted. Conversations must be taken out of the lab.
- Academic/educational activities have priority in the computer labs - during high demand periods, lab computers are **only** to be used for **academic purposes**

You are responsible for your personal property in the computer lab

Drinks in covered containers are allowed - **NO food is allowed**

You need your **MassBay One Card** to print, photocopy, etc.

The Technology Help Desk staff is responsible for lab computer problems:

- Please do **not** attempt to **modify** or **repair** equipment in the computer lab
- **Report** any problems to the Technology Help Desk staff
